Elena offers a model for transformational coaching which could be implemented as professional development in schools or districts anywhere. Although she addresses the needs of adult learners, her model maintains a student-centered focus, with a specific lens trained always on addressing equity issues in schools.


I am an instructional coach at The International School at Thornton Middle. Before coaching teachers, I taught Language Arts in the middle school for 14 years. I love


